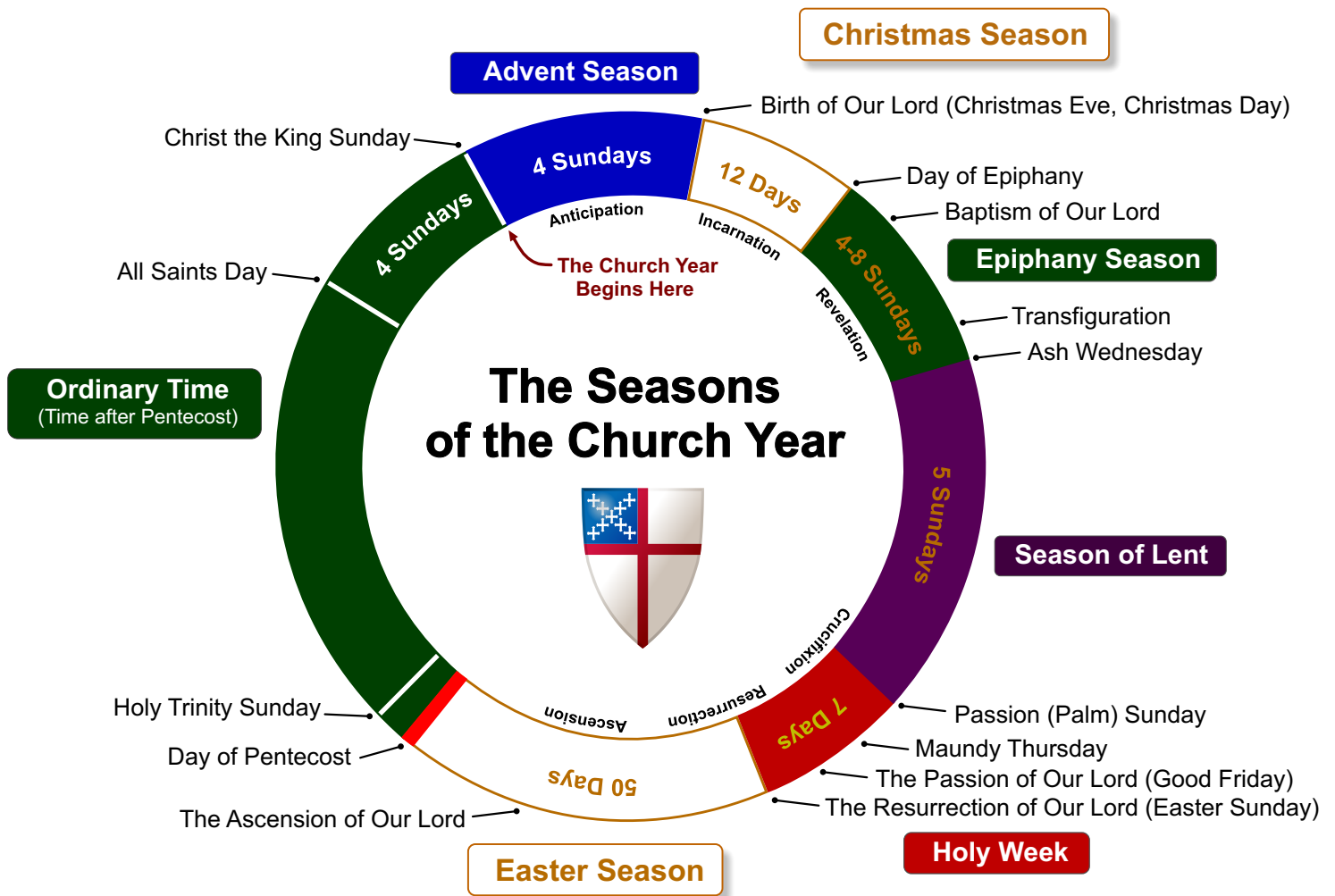


“Liturgical Colors” in Episcopal worship these colors are used to signify our place in the Church Year:



WHITE, the color of Jesus’ burial garments, for Christmas, Easter, and other ‘feasts’ or festival days, also for Marriages, and Funerals.

PURPLE/VIOLET or **ROYAL BLUE** for Advent, Lent (**OPTIONAL UNBLEACHED LINEN**).

RED for Holy Week, the Day of Pentecost, and at Ordinations.

GREEN during Epiphany, and the ‘Ordinary Time’ after Pentecost.
